

COTHAY MANOR & GARDENS 2010

Notes for Group leaders and Tour Organisers – we have written these to assist you with the smooth planning of your visit and should be grateful if you would pass on any relevant information to your party.

The definition of a Group is a minimum of 20 people. If a Group falls below 20 people, for whatever reason, the minimum Group charge will apply.

Sadly, due to some breakages, it is an absolute requirement of our insurance company that all bags, cameras, or any items being carried (with the exception of sticks with rubber tips), be deposited in our cloakroom before viewing the house. Coats and bulky cardigans should also be removed. This is because some rooms are very small and these items have in the past proved a danger to free standing objects. The cloakroom will of course be locked during the tour. Soft overshoes are provided, to be worn when viewing the manor. These are simple, disposable, and easily pulled on over your own shoes.

We have found that members of the group are more than happy to assist us in this way if it is explained to them in advance.

We have a small open-air tea-room for the general public which is open on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Sunday and Bank Holiday afternoons; it is not large enough to cater for groups and therefore groups are normally served in the Gatehouse.

Group catering must be pre-booked.

We would ask that all charges due in respect of your visit be calculated and collected prior to your arrival. This amount should also include payment for pre-booked refreshments.

DIRECTIONS TO COTHAY: from North exit M5 at J26 – direction WELLINGTON – take A38 direction EXETER – 3 ½ miles see BROWN SIGN on left – turn RIGHT to GREENHAM – follow BROWN SIGNS.

From WEST exit M5 at J27 – take A38 direction WELLINGTON – 3 ½ miles – see BROWN SIGN on left – follow BROWN SIGNS.

**WHEN IN THE LANE IT IS ONE MILE TO COTHAY –
IT WILL FEEL LIKE TEN – ALWAYS KEEP LEFT**
